INTRODUCTION

New Routes Foundation was established in December 2019 to support orphaned and vulnerable young adults in Kenya.

In the Rift Valley county of Elgeyo-Marakwet (where we are based), only 1.3% of secondary school students go on to achieve a university degree.

For orphaned students the opportunities are even less. This undoubtedly contributes to the county's very high subsistence farming and unemployment rate of 88%.

New Routes Foundation has been set up to give orphaned and vulnerable young adults the opportunity to attain a high quality university education and to equip them with all the skills and personal attributes to be successful.



As well as this, our holistic programme is strongly centred around discipleship. This is because we believe our students having a firm foundation in the Lord is infinitely more important than finding success in education and employment.

Through our programme, we hope to help bring an end to generational cycles of poverty and to nurture spiritually-mature young adults in this part of Kenya.

OUR PROGRAMME

UNIVERSITY

We fully sponsor our students during university or college, including:

- All course tuition fees through any university or college course
- Extra course related costs
- All living expenses

INTERNSHIPS

We provide our students with internship opportunities which give them improved access to jobs and allows them to develop the key skills and attributes they require to be successful throughout their careers.

This is in addition to attachments that they go for as part of their university course work.

DISCIPLESHIP

Our students stay with us for the first 3 months of the programme. During this time our students are encouraged to read the Bible and discover who God is on their own.

This continues whilst our students are at university via weekly Zoom calls and continued discipleship when they return for their short breaks.

MENTORING

We mentor our students throughout the entire programme.

Before our students head off to university, we run mentoring sessions where we discuss various life issues to prepare them for university living.

SKILLS COURSES

To give our students the best chance of success we teach them courses centred around life skills and employment skills:

- Financial Management
- Soft Skills
- Computer Skills
- Health & Wellbeing

PERSONAL PROJECT

We give our students the opportunity to run a fully-funded project of their choice.

We believe this allows them to further develop new skills they have learnt (budgeting, time management etc,), explore areas they are passionate about and gain experiences relevant to their chosen careers.







For the period 1 April 2021 - 31 March 2022 (£)






