Highlights of the Year

New Beneficiary Intake

In June 2023, we had our second beneficiary selection. After an intensive process of reviewing applications, conducting interviews and home visits, we took in 2 new beneficiaries Orpah and Caroline.





Orpah and Caroline moved into our compound, where we took them through our skills courses for 3 months (June to August) before they joined university.

During this period, we also began Christian mentorship and discipleship sessions with them, we are delighted to walk their university journey with them.





Highlights of the Year

Student Personal Project







Dennis, one of our beneficiaries, carried out his personal project in August 2023. He partnered with New Beginnings Crisis Pregnancy Center and Lelboinet Hospital to provide free ultrasound services to pregnant women in his village and donate diapers.

This three day activity saw just over thirty pregnant women get free ultrasounds - many of them who had not had the experience before.

He also distributed 150 diaper packs to the women within his community. Through this project, Dennis not only put his academic knowledge into practice, but he also served his village. This was a pivotal moment for us that fulfilled our desire to see our beneficiaries use their full potential to give back to their communities.






Finances (£)

For the period 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024









Finances (KES)
